### 13: Littleover Old Hall



Edward McInnes rebuilt the Old Hall in 1890 (pictured left prior to the rebuild) – and lived there with his family. Three boys and three girls, until 1922.

There was a cook, parlourmaid, housemaid, kitchenmaid, two nurses, a groom, a coachman, a farmer, a head gardener and his boy. And a woman called Ethel came from the village every week with a barrow to do the laundry.

Unfortunately one of the sons, John McInnes, died on the first day of the Battle of the Somme in 1916, he was only 21 years old.

In later years the Old Hall became home to the Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Service headquarters.
