## 2: The Post Office & North Street



The original village post office was over the road where the current garage stands. This picture is from 1910. There was a long garden in front, full of flowers and a pear tree by the front door.

It moved over to the other side of the road, into what had been Nellie Hummell's sweet shop. You can still see the original floor mosaic at the threshold.



North Street (named after Mr North the shoemaker) to the left of the Post Office was sometimes called Kinsey Street as Kinsey's Farm was on the right. It led to Donkey Lane, later to become Eastwood Drive.



The current postmaster is Dinesh Bhandari.
